

## Covid19 – Practitioner and client PPE guidelines

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Procedure / Policy: Practitioner and Client PPE guidelines

Description	Action
As a minimum, it is anticipated that practitioners should wear the PPE items listed across during the day.  <i>If your governing body / insurer requires further PPE, that is not a problem, but you may have to source it yourself. The disposable items listed here are what will be provided for use for all by The Centre (costs to each practitioner to be agreed)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Separate work clothes to those travelled in</li><li>- Surgical cloth face mask, or equivalent (Changed during the day as felt appropriate by practitioner)</li><li>- A visor</li></ul>
Extra items available for close contact therapies, where the contact is for more than 15mins (such as massage)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Plastic disposable apron (1 per appointment)</li></ul>
Extra items for cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Disposable gloves</li></ul>
As a minimum, it is anticipated that clients should wear the following PPE items during their appointment.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Surgical cloth face mask.</li></ul> <p>If client is not wearing one on arrival, it will be provided for free</p>
Extra items available, should client want to use (where appropriate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Disposable apron</li><li>- Disposable gloves</li></ul>
Use of towels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Any towels present in an appointment should be removed after the session and placed in the staff room ready for washing</li></ul> <p>Please only take enough towels for 1 appointment at a time and try to minimise the amount used. This will help with the extra laundry.</p>
