## Covid19 – Practitioner arrival and departure procedure

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Procedure / Policy: Practitioner arrival and departure procedure

Occurrence	Action
1. Travelling to work	<ul> <li>Practitioners should not come to work if displaying any symptoms that could be related to Covid-19</li> <li>A fever is common even if no other symptoms are present, therefore practitioners should take their temperature before departing for work</li> <li>Practitioners should have clothes for travelling to/from work that are different from their work attire</li> <li>They should also bring a bag for clothes to be stored in whilst at The Centre</li> <li>Practitioners should wear a face mask / covering for travel to work.</li> </ul>
2. Arrival at Centre	<ul> <li>Immediately use hand sanitiser in reception</li> <li>Proceed to staff room (1 occupant at a time only) or staff toilet to get changed</li> </ul>
3. Getting changed (start of day)  Guidelines currently suggest having separate travel and work clothes	<ul> <li>Please change into your work clothes and place your travelling clothes into your bag, use the hooks outside the staff toilet for storing items.</li> <li>If needed items of value can be locked away securely using existing facilities</li> </ul>

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	<ul> <li>Replace mask with a fresh one before leaving staff room</li> </ul>
4. Leaving the Centre (end of day)	<ul> <li>Ensure you have completed any relevant cleaning tasks.</li> <li>Please change back into your travel clothes and take your work clothes home to wash.</li> <li>Leave wearing a mask and hand sanitise in reception before you leave</li> </ul>

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
